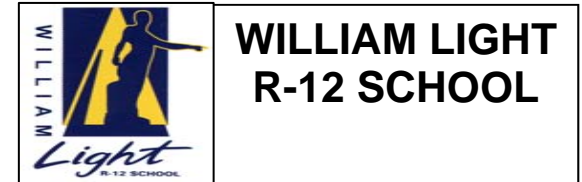

Certificate I in Racing (Stablehand)

Certificate I in Racing (Stablehand) is an opportunity for students who are interested in working in the Racing Industry.

In partnership with TAFESA at the Morphettville Racecourse, students will be able to work in the thoroughbred racing stable and also in the Horse Skills Centre at TAFESA Morphettville Campus.

Students will learn about caring for horses in relation to feeding, grooming, exercising and hygiene. The course is appropriate for stablehands who work under supervision.

Course Length

The course duration is one day a week for 15 weeks. Students will attend TAFESA Morphettville Campus from 9 am to 3 pm, to undertake both theory and practical studies.

Units of Competency

- Perform basic stable duties.
- Investigate job opportunities.
- Catch and handle quiet horses under supervision.
- Follow OHS procedures and observe environmental work practice.



SACE Credits

Students who successfully complete the course will receive 40 SACE credits.

Course Eligibility

Students enrolled in year 11 and 12 in 2010 are eligible to apply for the course. The course begins in week two, of semester one.
