Who do you call when...

- o your **vehicle breaks down** away from home and you need to get your horse home (or to a safe place)?
- o you need **emergency overnight accommodation** for your horse?
- o **you're injured** away from home (eg at a show) and need help with your horses?
- o **you're at a show**, and have a flat tyre, flat battery, have lost a shoe - and just generally need a helping hand?



The EEA aims at putting people in touch with other EEA members who can assist in a variety of equine-related emergency situations.

EEA members receive a Phone List of emergency contacts (fellow members) each month. The Phone List, kept in their vehicle, is a source of

contacts in equine-related emergency situations.

Companies are welcome to join if they provide 24x7 mobile / call out services.

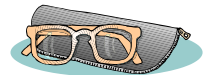
