Our horses are precious to us – for sport, recreation, racing, breeding or as valued and much-loved companions.

We want the best for them; we want to be the leaders in horse care and welfare.

Australia has a sound base of horse-related research; however funding levels need to improve to provide ongoing opportunities for our best young researchers and veterinarians.

We need to invest in research that helps us better care for and train high performance horses. The care of all horses, including stud stock, and a sound environmental approach to their keeping is equally important.

As a result of the research information being shared, all horse owners will have access to the very latest findings about keeping their horses healthy and happy.

Horse SA – a not-for-profit industry body – has seen the need to:

- establish a (tax deductible) fund, led by horse owners themselves;
- publicly demonstrate our support for fostering the skills and knowledge of young people to research leading edge horse health and welfare; and
- provide an opportunity for horse lovers to put aside money today, or in their wills as an ongoing legacy to the animals they love.

The Australian Horse Industry Research and Development Trust (The Horse Account) is a special fund, with its own constitution, which meets this need.

The Horse Account has the key role of assisting to provide the “in-kind” industry contribution required for

funding programs such as those provided through the Rural Industries Research & Development Corporation and other formalised research grant programs

The Trust is registered with the Australian Tax Office as a Deductible Gift Recipient Organisation (DGR)

## *We need your help !*

### Ways of Giving

There are lots of ways to help horse-related research!

- Donation (cash, products or services)
- Living Bequest
- Bequest (unrestricted or dedicated purpose)
- Bequest held in perpetuity
- Pay deductions

Or ... by conducting your own normal events, functions, race or showing classes and donating a proportion of the funds raised or won from all or part of the event.

Or ... owners of unwanted or old horses sold may consider contributing the monies received towards The Trust. What a great way to recognise a valued friend!

You may even think of other great ideas for finding ways to encourage contributions amongst colleagues or friends.



### Bequests

When planning bequests, consider horses!

You may wish to give to The Horse Account in general or to request that funds are held for a specific purpose.

Here is some sample wording you may like to consider. It is always advisable to receive legal advice when preparing your will.

#### Unrestricted Bequest:

I give (my estate) or (portion/the residue of my estate) or (the sum of \$\_\_) to ‘The Australian Horse Industry Research and Development Trust’ for general purposes. I declare that the receipt of the authorised officer for the gift shall be sufficient to discharge to my trustees.

#### Dedicated Bequest:

I give (my estate) or (portion/the residue of my estate) to ‘The Australian Horse Industry Research and Development Trust’ to be applied for a specific purpose. I express the wish but without creating any binding trust that if practical this gift will be applied to one of the following purposes, as listed.

I declare that the receipt of the authorised officer for the gift shall be sufficient discharge to my trustees.
